### Work Criteria

- Grades K-12 are eligible.
- Artwork must be original in content.
- Vertical format, No larger than 18" x 24" (Smaller artwork can be mounted on thin tag board)
- Artwork should NOT be matted. (MAA provides mats)
- Create an MAEA label for each submission. (Email or Print & Mail but do not attach labels)
- No canvases, no relief, flat 2D artwork only, no backing needed.
- Reproductions of student work is acceptable
- Information to be placed on back of each artwork & on a separate paper to be mail with work:**  
**Title, Student name and grade, County, School, School address and phone #, Student address and phone #, Teacher name, Medium**
